A safety assessment of cosmetic products is of high importance. All manufacturers and brand owners are responsible for offering safe products to consumers. The contents of the safety assessment and also the qualification of the safety assessor are legally defined in some regions like e.g. the European Union (EU). However, a person who meets the qualification is not necessarily qualified to carry out a safety assessment, as the experience and training are of major importance as well.

For this purpose - already 20 years ago - The German Cosmetic, Toiletry, Perfumery and Detergent Association (IKW) and The German Society for Scientific and Applied Cosmetics (DGK) developed a training concept that is unique in the world. Through individual training segments, it offers the opportunity to achieve the "DGK Safety Assessor" certificate.

Many countries who do not have such a legal requirement are now looking at the EU system. This led to the decision to offer this training concept in English. IKW and DGK will now offer these courses as webinars, opening the possibility for those interested worldwide to enjoy this successful training concept online, with the CTFA as the South African representative for this training.

At the same time, **seminars** will be held in the various regions with local Associations, in South Africa it will be the Cosmetic Toiletries & Fragrance Association (CTFA), where safety assessors and those who want to become involved will have the opportunity to learn about innovations while gaining hands-on experience in workshops with peers.

During the Coschem Conference and HPCI Exhibition on the 4 and 5 September at the Gallagher Exhibition Center in Johannesburg, South Africa, all specialists who are interested can get more information about safety assessments in the seminar program designed by IKW and DGK e.V. together with CTFA South Africa.
